Enchanted Journey II - Chevrons

Quilt Designed by Debbie Wharton with Southwest Decoratives for Avlyn Creations
Approximate Size: 43 1/2" x 60 1/2"

All seam allowances are 1/4". Please read all directions before beginning and press carefully after each step. Border measurements are approximate, always measure your quilt top before cutting border lengths.

Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
A. Enchanted Journey II Fabrics	3" of each fabric	Cut 2 - 1 1/2" x WOF strip of each of 23 Enchanted Journey II Fabrics (46 strips)
B. Corner Stone (Black)	1/8 yard	Cut 2 - 1 1/2" x WOF strip, cut into 39 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares
C. Floating Block Border (Turquoise Batik)	1/2 yard	Cut 12 - 1 1/2" x WOF strip
D. Rust Pima Baskets	1/2 yard	Cut 1 - 9 3/4" x WOF strip, sub cut 4 - 9 3/4" x 9 3/4" squares
E. Jade Diamonds	1/4 yard	Cut 1 - 5 1/8" x WOF strip, sub-cut 2 - 5 1/8" x 5 1/8" squares
F. Midnight Chevrons	3/4 yard	Cut 5 - 1" x WOF strip
G. Binding (Enchanted Journey II Fabric)	1/2 yard	Cut 5 - 4 1/2" x WOF strip
H. Backing	3 yards	Cut 6 - 2 1/2" x WOF strip

Sewing Directions:

Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout unless otherwise indicated. Sew pieces with right sides together and raw edges even with matching or neutral threads.

Chevron Block - 39 Blocks

1. Sub cut Fabric A (1 1/2" Enchanted Journey II strips) randomly into:

A1. 39 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares
 A4/A5. 78 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
 A6/A7. 78 - 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
 A8/C1. 78 - 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
 C2. 39 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

2. Sew Fabric B to A1 as shown in Fig. 1
3. Sew Fabric A2 to Unit B/A1 as shown in Fig. 2
4. Sew Fabric A3 to Unit B/A1/A2 as shown in Fig. 3. Continue sewing "A4 - A8 as shown in Fig. 3
5. Sew Fabric C1 and C2 to B/A1-A9 units as shown in Fig. 4. Block should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

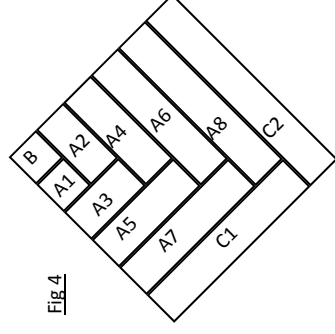
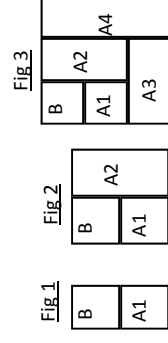

Note: The Chevron Block is a directional block with Fabric B (black) positioned at the top of the block.

Setting Blocks

1. Using Fabric D - Cut the 4 - 9 3/4" x 9 3/4" squares diagonally twice to create 16 large triangle setting side blocks as shown (Fig 5).

2. Using Fabric D - Cut the 2 - 5 1/8" x 5 1/8" squares diagonally once to create 4 small setting corner blocks as shown (Fig. 5).

Quilt Construction:

1. Refer to Quilt Center Layout Diagram. Start with Row 1 - sew large setting blocks to both sides of Chevron Block taking care that the black batik center square (Fabric B) is positioned at the top of the block. Sew a small setting corner block as shown on the layout diagram. Sew Row 9 in the same manner - refer to the layout diagram for setting block placement.
2. Construct Rows 2 - 8 as shown in the Quilt Center Layout Diagram.
3. Sew Row 1 to Row 2, Row 3 to Row 4, etc until the entire center is sewn together.
4. Inner Border: Using Fabric E, cut one 1" strip into two sections and attach to 2 - 1" x WOF side borders. Sew side inner borders then the top and bottom borders.
5. Outer Border: Using Fabric F, cut one strip into two sections and attach to 2 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the top and bottom outer border first, then add the side outer borders.
6. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt and Enjoy!
