## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Pattern #16258 – MUL 1.....	7/8 yard
16258 – RED 1.....	1/2 yard
18100 – CRE 1.....	1/2 yard
18101 – BRO 1.....	1/3 yard
18102 – ROS 1.....	1 7/8 yards
18103 – GRE 1.....	1/4 yard
18103 – WIN 1.....	1 1/8 yards (includes binding)
18104 – GRE 1.....	1/3 yard
18105 – GOL 1.....	1/2 yard
18105 – GRE 1.....	1/4 yard
18105 – ROS 1.....	1/2 yard
18105 – WIN 1.....	1/4 yard
18106 – GRE 1.....	1/2 yard
18106 – RED 1.....	1/2 yard
Backing (fabric of choice).....	4 yards
Batting.....	70" x 82"

### Additional supplies:

Fusible web for appliqué quarter circles  
Invisible thread

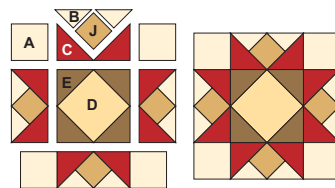
## APPLIQUÉ PREPARATION:

Fuse web to wrong side of fabric following the manufacturer's instructions. For each color, trace twenty quarter circle templates onto fusible web and cut out on traced line.

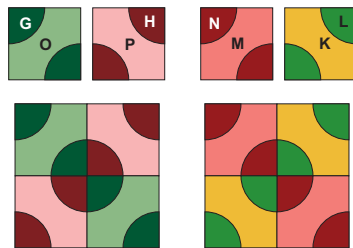
## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS: Use 1/4" seam allowances.

### Paradox Blocks:

1. Sew an E triangle to each side of a D square to make the center unit.
2. Sew a B triangle to two adjacent sides of a J square. Sew a C triangle to the short sides of B/J to complete a star point unit. Sew four units for each block.
3. Sew a star point unit to opposite sides of the center unit. Sew an A square to each side of the remaining two star point units and sew to remaining two sides. Make ten blocks.

### Puzzle Blocks:

1. Follow the APPLIQUÉ PREPARATION directions above. Fuse the quarter circles to the 6 1/2" squares as shown.
2. Machine appliqué the quarter circles in place using invisible thread. Make forty units.
3. Sew the units together in sets of four to complete the blocks. Make ten blocks, five in each color combination.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to cover photo.

1. Sew the blocks together in five rows of four blocks each, alternating Paradox and Puzzle blocks in each row. Sew rows together.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

### A. Pattern #16258 – MUL1 (vines):

1. Cut four 3 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut forty 3 1/2" squares (A).
2. Cut three 4 1/4" x 42" strips. Crosscut twenty 4 1/4" squares, and then cut on diagonal twice to yield eighty triangles (B).

### B. Pattern #16258 – RED1 (vines):

1. Cut four 3 7/8" x 42" strips. Crosscut forty 3 7/8" squares, and then cut on diagonal once to yield eighty triangles (C).

### C. Pattern #18100 – CRE1 (apples):

1. Cut two 4 3/4" x 42" strips. Crosscut ten 4 3/4" squares (D).

### D. Pattern #18101 – BRO1 (blossoms):

1. Cut two 3 7/8" x 42" strips. Crosscut twenty 3 7/8" squares, and then cut on diagonal once to yield forty triangles (E).

### E. Pattern #18102 – ROS1 (geometric):

1. Cut eight 7 1/2" x 42" strips. Sew together end-to-end. Recut into two 70" horizontal outer borders and two 80" vertical outer borders (F).

### F. Pattern #18103 – GRE1 (cranes):

1. Follow APPLIQUÉ PREPARATION directions to fuse and cut out twenty quarter circles (G).

### G. Pattern #18103 – WIN1 (cranes):

1. Follow APPLIQUÉ PREPARATION directions to fuse and cut out twenty quarter circles (H).
2. Cut six 1 1/2" x 42" strips. Sew together

end-to-end. Cut two vertical inner borders 60 1/2" long and two horizontal inner borders 50 1/2" long (I).

3. Cut seven 2 1/4" x 42" strips for binding.

### H. Pattern #18104 – GRE1 (tie dye):

1. Cut three 2 5/8" x 42" strips. Crosscut forty 2 5/8" squares (J).

### I. Pattern #18105 – GOL1 (baby rattles):

1. Cut two 6 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut ten 6 1/2" squares (K).

### J. Pattern #18105 – GRE1 (baby rattles):

1. Follow APPLIQUÉ PREPARATION directions to fuse and cut out twenty quarter circles (L).

### K. Pattern #18105 – ROS1 (baby rattles):

1. Cut two 6 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut ten 6 1/2" squares (M).

### L. Pattern #18105 – WIN1 (baby rattles):

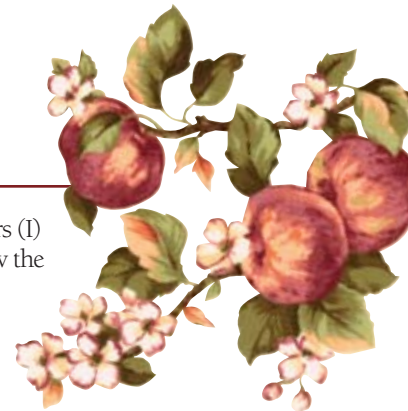
1. Follow APPLIQUÉ PREPARATION directions to fuse and cut out twenty quarter circles (N).

### M. Pattern #18106 – GRE1 (plaid):

1. Cut two 6 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut ten 6 1/2" squares (O).

### N. Pattern #18106 – RED1 (plaid):

1. Cut two 6 1/2" x 42" strips. Crosscut ten 6 1/2" squares (P).



2. Inner Border: Sew the vertical borders (I) to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the horizontal borders (I) to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
3. Outer Border: Fold the four border strips (F) in half end-to-end and press the center fold line. Pin the center of a vertical border strip to the center of one side of the quilt top. Pin from the center to the outside edge of both ends stopping 1/4" from the edge of the quilt top. Sew border strip in place. Sew remaining three border strips in the same manner. Miter each corner, trim excess, and press seams open.

## FINISHING:

1. Prepare backing with a horizontal seam to measure 70" x 82".
2. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim the backing and batting even with the quilt top.
5. Join the binding strips together with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding to quilt using your favorite method.
