Panel Quilts

Materials for the Blue Version

2/3 yard	Yellow Printed Panel F5885-44 (one full panel)
3/4 yard	Blue Stars F5890-11 (includes binding)
1/4 yard	Yellow Bunnies F5887-44
3/4 yard	Blue Scenic F5889-11
5/8 yard	Blue Check F5888-11
1 7/8 yards	Off-White Scenic F5889-4 (for quilt backing)

Materials for the Pink Version

2/3 yard	Pink Printed Panel F5885-22 (one full panel)
3/4 yard	Pink Stars F5890-22 (includes binding)
1/4 yard	Green Bunnies F5887-66
3/4 yard	Off-White Scenic F5889-4
5/8 yard	Pink Check F5888-22
1 7/8 yards	Animal Squares F5886-21 (for quilt backing)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From the printed panel, cut:

- (1) 22½" wide x 40½" long piece with the printed motifs centered in the cut piece.

From the blue *OR* pink stars, cut:

- (5) 2½" strips for the binding.
- (5) 2" strips. Set aside (4) strips for the inner border. Recut (1) strip into (20) 2" x 2" squares.

From the yellow *OR* green bunnies, cut:

- (1) 3½" strip. Recut into (4) 3½" x 3½" and (4) 2" x 2" squares.
- (1) 2" strip. Recut into (20) 2" x 2" squares.

From the blue *OR* off-white scenic, cut:

- (4) 5" strips for the middle border.

From the blue *OR* pink check, cut:

- (5) 3½" strips for the outer border.

Sewing Instructions

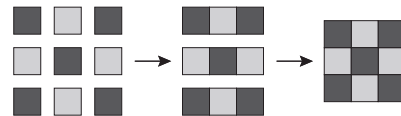
All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Trim (2) 2" star print inner border strips to 40½". Stitch a trimmed strip to the left and right sides of the trimmed printed panel unit. Trim (2) 2" star print inner border strips to 22½". Sew a 2" bunnies print square to each end of each trimmed strip. Stitch a pieced border to the top and bottom of the trimmed panel unit.

2. (**Blue Version**) Arrange (5) 2" blue star print and (4) 2" yellow bunnies print squares into (3) rows with (3) squares in each row.

2. (**Pink Version**) Arrange (5) green bunnies print squares and (4) 2" star print squares into (3) rows with (3) squares in each row.

2. (**Both Versions**) Stitch the squares into rows. Sew the rows together to make (1) 5" x 5" nine-patch block. Repeat to make a total of (4) nine-patch blocks.



3. Trim the selvages from the 5" scenic print strips and sew the strips together end to end to make a long 5" strip. From this long strip cut (2) 43½" and (2) 25½" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Stitch the longer lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew a nine-patch block from step 2 to each end of the two shorter lengths. Stitch a pieced border to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

4. Trim the selvages from (3) 3½" check strips and sew the strips together end to end to make a long 3½" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 52½" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Stitch these lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top.

5. Trim (2) 3½" check strips to 34½" (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Sew a 3½" bunnies print square to each end of each trimmed strip. Stitch a pieced border to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

6. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.

7. Bind the finished quilt using the 2½" star print binding strips.

3/4 yard	Blue Bunnies	F5887-11
3/4 yard	Yellow Bunnies	F5887-44
3/4 yard	Green Bunnies	F5887-66
1 1/4 yards	Blue Check <i>(includes binding)</i>	F5888-11
1 1/2 yards	Green Scenic	F5889-66
5/8 yard	Blue Stars	F5890-11
3/4 yard	Fluffy Off-White	Solid
4 1/2 yards	Off-White Scenic <i>(for quilt backing)</i>	F5889-4

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From the blue bunnies, cut:

- (2) 10 7/8" strips. Recut into (5) 10 7/8" x 10 7/8" and (2) 8" x 8" squares. Recut each square in half on one diagonal to yield (2) triangles. Stay-stitch along the long edge of each 10 7/8" triangle to prevent stretching.



From the yellow bunnies, cut:

- (2) 10 1/2" strips. Recut into (6) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares.

From the green bunnies, cut:

- (9) 2 1/2" strips. Recut (6) strips into (48) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces and (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

From the blue check, cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" strips. Recut into (24) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares.
- (7) 2 1/2" strips for the binding.

From the green scenic, cut:

- (7) 7" strips for the outer border.

From the blue stars, cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" strips for the inner border.

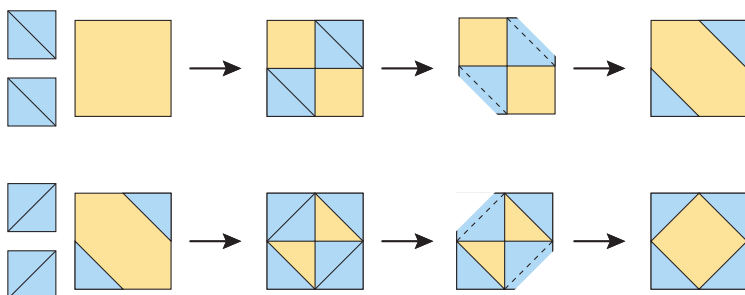
From the fluffy off-white solid, cut:

- (9) 2 1/2" strips. Recut (6) strips into (48) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces.

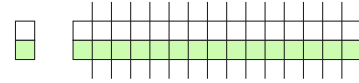
Sewing Instructions

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong sides of (4) 5 1/2" blue check squares. Layer marked squares in opposite corners of a 10 1/2" yellow bunnies square, right sides together. Sew on the marked lines. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam lines and press the resulting triangles out as shown. Repeat this procedure for the remaining corners of the yellow bunnies square. To complete (1) block. Repeat to make a total of (6) yellow bunnies/blue check blocks.



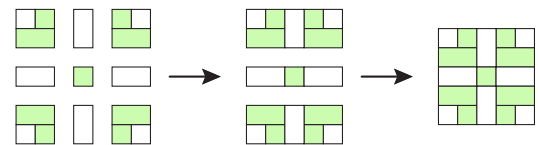
2. Sewing lengthwise, stitch 2 1/2" green bunnies and off-white solid strips together to yield a 4 1/2" high strip set. Repeat to make a total of (3) strip sets. From these strip sets, cut a total of (48) 2 1/2" wide segments.



3. Stitch a strip set segment from step 1 to a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" green bunnies piece to make (1) block corner unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) block corner units.



4. Arrange (4) block corner units, (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" off-white pieces, and (1) 2 1/2" green bunnies square into (3) rows with (3) units in each row. Stitch the units into rows. Sew the rows together to complete (1) green bunnies/off-white solid block.



5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to make a total of (12) green bunnies/off-white solid blocks.

Quilt Assembly

1. Using the quilt pictured on the cover as a guide, arrange the two types of blocks and the 10 7/8" blue bunnies triangles into (6) diagonal rows, alternating the two types of blocks as shown. Stitch the blocks and triangles into rows and sew the rows together. Sew an 8" blue bunnies triangle to each corner to complete the quilt center.
2. Trim the selvages from the 2 1/2" blue stars inner border strips and sew the strips together end to end to make a long 2 1/2" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 57" and (2) 46 7/8" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Stitch the longer lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the shorter lengths to the top and bottom.
3. Trim the selvages from the 7" green scenic outer border strips and sew the strips together end to end to make a long 7" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 61" and (2) 59 7/8" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Stitch the longer lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the shorter lengths to the top and bottom.
4. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.
5. Bind the finished quilt using the 2 1/2" blue check strips.
