

Fabric	TURQ #s	BLACK #s	Yardage	Description, Placement
Fabric A	8624-0118	8640-0112	1-1/8 yards	large paisley print, blocks A, borders #3 Cut (3) 5-1/2" x wof, sew together end-to-end then cut (2) 5-1/2" x 58-1/2" borders Cut (2) 12-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (5) 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" squares
Fabric B*	8625-0150	8641-0147	1/4 yard	small paisley, print blocks B Cut (3) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (8) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces
Fabric C	8626-0118	8626-0140	1-1/2 yards	stripe Cut (7) 6-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut (2) side borders 6-1/2" x 72-1/2" and (2) top/bottom borders 6-1/2" x 54-1/2"
Fabric D	8627-0118	8643-0112*	1/2 yard	medallions, blocks B Cut (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces Cut (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" pieces
Fabric E	8642-0113	8643-0112*	1/4 yard	medallions, block B, border squares Cut (1) 4-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (8) 4-1/2" squares
Fabric F	8628-0113	8628-0112	1-1/8 yard	damask print, border #1, binding Cut (6) 2-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut (2) 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" side borders and (2) 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom borders Cut (9) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding
Fabric G	8628-0150	8628-0141	2/3 yard	damask print, border #2, corner squares Cut (12) 1-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end and recut into (2) 1-1/2" x 72-1/2" side borders and (4) 1-1/2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom borders; then cut (8) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (8) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces for border corners
Fabric H	8628-0120	8628-0144	1/2 yard	damask print, blocks B Cut (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces Cut (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" pieces
Fabric I	8629-0113	8629-0144	1/3 yard	texture print, blocks B Cut (4) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (16) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces
Fabric J	8629-0112	8629-0133	3/4 yard	texture print, blocks A Cut (2) 12-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (20) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces
Fabric K	8630-0118	8630-0133	1/4 yard	dots, blocks A Cut (2) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (20) 3-1/2" squares
Fabric L	8630-0113	8630-0140	1/8 yard	dots, blocks B Cut (1) 2-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (16) 2-1/2" squares
*Backing	8625-0150	8641-0147	5-1/8 yards	Cut into 2 equal pieces and sew together selvedge to selvedge

Making the Quilt



Note: Sew all seams with a 1/4" seam allowance and press all seams as you sew.

Block A: Sew a fabric J 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip to opposite sides of a fabric A 12-1/2" square. Sew a fabric K 3-1/2" square to opposite sides of (2) fabric J 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips. Sew the J/K strips to the top and bottom of the center section of the block. Make 5 blocks.

Block B: Sew a fabric B 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece to opposite sides of a fabric E 4-1/2" square. Sew a fabric B 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of this unit. Sew a fabric I 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to opposite sides of the center block unit. Sew a fabric L 2-1/2" square to opposite sides of (2) fabric I 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces, then sew these units to the top/bottom of the center block unit. Sew a fabric D 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to one end of a fabric H 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip. Make (2) units for each block for a total of (8) units. Sew a fabric D 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to one end of a fabric H 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip. Make (2) units for each block for a total of (8) units. Sew the short units D/H to opposite sides of a quilt block center. Sew the long D/H units to the top/bottom quilt block center. Make 4 blocks.

Sew the blocks together into (3) rows of (3) blocks each, alternating blocks A and B. Rows 1 and 3 begins and ends with a block A and row 2 begins and ends with a block B.

Border #1: Sew the fabric F 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" borders to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew the fabric F 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" borders to the top/bottom of the quilt center.

Borders #2 and #3: Sew a fabric G 1-1/2" x 58-1/2" border #2 strip to opposite sides of a fabric A 5-1/2" x 58-1/2" border #3 strip to make a G-A-G border unit. Make 2 units. Sew these units to the top/bottom of the quilt center.

Sew a fabric G 1-1/2" x 72-1/2" border strip to one side of a fabric C 6-1/2" x 72-1/2" border strip. Make 2. Sew these borders to opposite sides of the quilt top.

Border Corners: Sew a fabric G 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" to opposite sides of a fabric E 4-1/2" square. Sew a fabric G 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" square to the top/bottom of these units to complete a corner square. Make 4.

Borders #4: Sew a corner border block to each end of the (2) fabric C 6-1/2" x 58-1/2" border strips. Sew the borders to the top/bottom of the quilt to complete the project.

Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt the layers together. Bind to finish the outside edges.


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Quilt Assembly Diagram
